
Whether you want someone to come in before each meal time to make your meal fresh or come and make you a few meals to reheat later on, we are excited to make your life easier!

Medication Management

All of our carers are medication trained so if you need us to help you take them and keep track of your health, we can be of assistance.

Medication is a breeze when someone manages it for you!

Medication Management can be implemented into any of our other services also; if you need medication before a meal, ask for medication when we come to prepare your meals. If your medication needs to be implemented into your morning routine, we can help you with it during personal care.

If medication is the only thing that you struggle to manage, we can just come in and help you with that and stop for a chat at the same time!



Hospital Discharge Support

After spending some time in hospital, making the transition back home can be tough.

We can send a carer out to help you make the transition, assist you with any physio exercises you may need to do, familiarise you with any new equipment that you have or just spend time with you to keep you company.

Perhaps your stay in hospital has made you require on-going personal care, maybe you now have more medication to manage or you need to establish ish a routine and we can help with this. Once you have properly settled in after you have transitioned home, you may find that you have become used to us visiting you; if this is the case, we are more than happy to review your care plan and discuss your requirements.



Live-in Care/Overnight Care

Live-in care is a fantastic service that we provide, whether you just need round-the-clock support or you're considering going to a care home but don't want to give up your home, Live-in Care could be for you!

Our Core Beliefs

HoneyBee HomeCare is a company that is totally person centred. From our clients to our staff, we wanted to double down on this by associating ourselves with certain organisations.

We believe that care staff should be treated with respect, support and fairness which is often overlooked in the care sector. To maintain this we keep in regular touch with our staff, offering them regular opportunities to express their thoughts, ideas, compliments, opinions and concerns to us.

Care staff are often underpaid; we used this fact as a driving force for ourselves from the very beginning, to ensure we pay a fair wage we have become National Living Wage Association accredited, this legally obliges us to pay the "real" living wage set by the association. We wanted to up this by paying 10% above that to really ensure our carers are properly reimbursed for their hard work.

We are also associated with Dementia Friends to enable ourselves to educate our staff about the realities of dementia and dementia care. With this we can be sure that we are taking a considerate, professional and sensitive approach to any of our clients that may be suffering with dementia.

Alongside this, we are encouraging our staff to sign up to be Dignity Champions with the National Dignity Council which means they will abide and encourage others to abide by the "10 dignity dos and don'ts". Both Dignity Champions and Dementia Friends are considerations that we all take out of work-time and appreciate and apply to the general public.

We want to ensure that we are doing everything we can to assure our clients and staff that we are a truly caring organisation with people at our hearts.

My Learning Cloud: We use this online system to train our staff members on all aspects of care. This training system goes in depth on multiple topics that range from personal care to medication and beyond. It's a worthwhile service that had educated our staff and refreshed their knowledge of modern care practices. 
